Wiki

Navigating the Wiki

- Accessible
 - from our network
 - from internet after login
- Public Front Page
- Log in using your dept. account
- Nonpublic Front Page

Navigating the Wiki

- Name of current page
- Going back
- Go to Front Page by clicking on top image
- How to find a page
 - Search
 - FindPage
- Adding Quick Links
- Seeing recent changes
- Subscribing to pages

Editing the Wiki

- Try editing e.g. on your own page
 - (Create your own page by clicking on your name next to "Preferences")
- Click on Edit (Text) or Edit (GUI)
 - GUI editor is not recommended.
 - Text editor is not that difficult
- Use preview experiment!
- Syntax examples
 - bold, heading, list, table

Editing the Wiki

- Make a link
 - To a wiki page: [[PageName|Description]]
 - To an external page: [[http://www.dn.se|DN]]
- Create a new page
 - Make link to it
 - Click on the link, then on Create new empty page
- How to add an attachment
 - Upload the file
 - Then add: [[attachment: file name|description|&do=get]]

Editing the Wiki

- Include Latex and HTML code
- Latex:

{{{#!latex

```
$f(x)=x$
}}}

• html:
{{{#!html}
<h1>This is html</h1>
}}}
```

Permissions

- Every page has permissions defined by the #acl line.
 - read, write, delete, revert, admin
- Can be given to users or groups
 - erik, berntorp, Known, All
 - Known = logged in
- Structure
 - #acl user1:permissions user2:permissions
- Examples:
 - #acl erik:read,write,delete,admin berntorp:read
 - #acl Known:read,write,admin All:read

Permissions

- New pages will have Known:read,write,admin,delete,revert
- No acl line equals Known:write,read,delete,admin,revert
- To make a page public, add All:read
- Careful: only having #acl All:read means you can't edit
- Admins can always write, read, delete, admin, revert
 - Ask an admin if you lock yourself out
 - Don't keep things on the wiki that unless you want to share it with the dept

Editing Guidelines

- All pages should be in english
- Use preview to avoid saving errors
- Adding a link? Make sure it works!
- Avoid changing page names, it breaks links
- Don't be afraid to change, add or remove stuff
- Don't know how to do something? Ask!
- Page discussions
 - Explain here if you make a major change
